- **About:** Obstacle course set up with 4 different stations spread over approx. 5 miles of trail. Versatile using horse challenges. (Possibilities: low jump, rope bale of hay, ground tie, gates, ground poles, cut a fence, etc)
- **Divisions:** Open, Youth, (Under 18), Novice, Exhibition. Exhibition is for riders who wish to ride along with the competitors, but not participate in the judged obstacles. Bring green or finished horses.
